- BEA Union Investment Asia Pacific Multi Income Fund (the "Fund") invests in emerging markets and may be subject to higher liquidity and volatility risks.

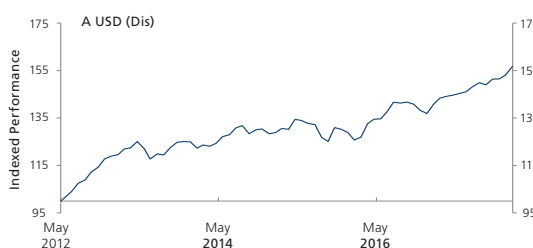
