Investment Holdings Diversified Amid Increasing Market Volatility



Highlights:

Fund Features

- The Fund focuses on high yielding Asia Pacific bonds and equities, distributions from both bonds and equities are the main source of income.

Market Review and Outlook

Bonds

- 10-year U.S. Treasury yields remained largely range-bound at around 2.85% to 3% in June and were still flat at 2.86% at the end of June. This was largely due to risk-off sentiment and a halt in hawkish statements from the Federal Reserve.
- Overall, Asian high yield bond markets continued to experience some correction in June because of risk-off sentiment, but current valuation looks attractive given their fundamentals remain solid.
- Asian investment grade bond market is benefiting from the reduction of primary issuance and the stabilisation of U.S. Treasury yields.

Equities

- Chinese onshore and offshore equity markets both fell in June due to the risk-off sentiment triggered by escalating U.S.-China trade tensions.
- The Hong Kong market extended its earlier decline in June as a result of the weakness in Chinese equities. The utilities sector outperformed due to market uncertainty, while Chinese banks and property sector underperformed.
- The Australian market enjoyed another strong month in June, with its energy sector outperforming as a result of higher oil prices. The nation's quarterly GDP figures are above market expectation, driven mainly by export growth.

Investment Strategy

Bonds

- The Fund remains defensive in June. It continued to reduce its exposure in high yield bonds, while holding on to more defensive investment grade bonds with better credit quality.
- The Fund continued to hold more defensive short-dated bonds and retained a higher level of cash in view of market volatility.

Equities

- The Fund took the opportunity to diversify its holdings as trade tensions increased market volatility.
- The Fund continues to invest in higher yielding names in Australia, Taiwan, and Singapore while also reducing currency risk. We remain positive about the banking sector, which stands to benefit from upcoming interest rate hikes.
